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4. FIRST AID MEASURES

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Suitable Extinguishing Media: Use carbon dioxide, dry chemical, foam or water mist.Hazards from Combustion Products: Combustible liquid. This product will burn if exposed to fire.Special Protection Equipment: Fire-fighters should wear full protective clothing and self contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) in case of fire.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Emergency Procedures: Personnel to wear appropriate personal protective equipment and clothing to minimise exposure. Remove all sources of ignition. Stop leaks where safe to do so. Ventilate area. Use inert absorbent onto spillage to avoid spillage from entering drains or waterways. Use non sparking tools to collect material, and place in to labelled containers. Dispose of waste materials in accordance with local and national regulations. If spillage enters waterways contact the Environmental Protection Authority or local water authority.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Precautions for Safe Handling: Use in a well ventilated area. Wear appropriate protective equipment and clothing to avoid inhalation of fumes or mist, contact with skin and eyes. Containers not in use should be closed. Do not smoke. Always wash hands after handling and prior to eating, drinking, smoking or using the toilet.

Conditions for Safe Storage: for the purposes of storage and handling. Store in a cool, well ventilated area away from heat and other sources of ignition, oxidising agents, foodstuffs, and out of direct sunlight. Keep containers securely sealed and protect against damage. Water contamination should be avoided

National Exposure Standards: No exposure standard has been established, however, the TWA National Occupational Health and Safety Commission (NOHSC) exposure standard for oil mist is 5 mg/m³. As with all chemicals, exposure should be kept to the lowest possible level.
